

Privacy Act Statement. 



Dear Mr. Ambassador:

This letter, when signed by you and returned to us, will constitute an agreement by the Government of Angola to retain the services of Strategic Policy, Inc.

This agreement will commence on February 22, 1994 and will remain in effect through May 21, 1994, or until terminated as specified herein. It is agreed that either party may cancel this agreement upon 30 days' written notice.

In consideration of our providing our services the Government of Angola will pay our firm a fee of \$30,000.00. Those services will include the following:

- Assist the Embassy and the Ambassador in arranging meetings with key members of Congress and staff; accompany the Ambassador and staff to such meetings;
- Prepare documents and letters for the Ambassador and Embassy staff;
- Arrange press interviews for the Ambassador and staff and, when appropriate, accompany them to such meetings;
- Provide advice to the Ambassador and staff on the best way to convey the story of Angola's problems and its needs.

Payment of fees will be due in full upon the signing of this contract.


It is understood that our firm may assign such professional personnel to work on matters for you as we shall deem reasonable and advisable and in the best interest of the Government of Angola.

It is understood that our firm will keep confidential all information received from you which you advise us is confidential.

This agreement will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the District of Columbia. Strategic Policy, Inc. will register with and report to the US Department of Justice as required by the Foreign Agents Registration Act.


