

MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Consulting Contract
September 1, 1992 to August 31, 1993

This document, when countersigned by you, will constitute the agreement between the Board of Foreign Trade, Ministry of Economic Affairs (hereinafter referred to as "Board") and Robert G. Beckel/BBA, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "BBA") for reporting and informational services.

1. BBA will provide information, analysis and advice on likely developments in American economic, trade and political matters which are of interest to the Board.
2. BBA will recommend informational activities (briefings, visits, seminars, press releases, etc.) that will most effectively respond to these developments.
3. BBA will provide oral and written analyses of the 1992 presidential election.
4. BBA will provide both oral and written briefings throughout the year on a regular basis and as requested by the Board.
5. In consideration of the aforementioned services provided to the Board by BBA, the Board agrees to pay BBA a fee of \$10,000.00 per month, payable at the beginning of each month, plus reasonable out-of-pocket expenses, not to exceed \$20,000.00 for the year (including, but not limited to, such items as travel, food and lodging, postage, copying, courier, computer and research).


6. The term of this agreement shall be from September 1, 1992, through August 31, 1993. The parties may agree to negotiate a new contract prior to the termination of this one.
7. All information provided to the Board by us during the course of this contract shall be for the use of the Board itself, and shall not be made public without the express consent of BBA.
8. BBA and the Board understand that the services that are provided herein by BBA are for the unique experience and capabilities of Robert G. Beckel and that all conditions and warrants are made by and through him.
9. This agreement may be terminated by either the Board or BBA upon 90 days written notice to the other.

If the foregoing meets with your approval, I would appreciate your signing both copies of this memorandum where indicated and returning one copy to me. Please keep the other for your files.

My colleagues and I look forward to the opportunity to continue working with you.
