TRANSPORTATION

PUBLIC BUSES
Regularly scheduled buses operate at frequent intervals to most of the destinations throughout Bermuda which visitors find of interest. There is a Central Bus Terminal on Washington Street in Hamilton, just off Church Street and a few steps east of the City Hall & Arts Centre. Bus stops are designated throughout the island either by pink or blue poles - solid pink - throughout the island, solid blue - outboard from the City of Hamilton.

MINI BUSES

Privately operated mini buses' standards and fares are regulated by the Government of Bermuda. They provide single rates and sightseeing tours. Mini buses are a good alternative for large groups wishing to visit Bermuda's attractions.

TAXIS

Heed by the hour day or mile. Special all-inclusive pre-ord tours vary in price per person. A 3-hr tour is suggested for a tour of the island. All rates are metered and listed by law by Summary of Rates.

FERRIES

Ferries operate to and from City of Hamilton, Paget, Warwick and the West End including Royal Naval Dockyard all year to St. George's April to November only. For fare details see separate leaflets on board.

ELECTRIC VEHICLES

Mostly of conventional rental cars, Bermuda electric vehicles are indicated by black and white zebra stripes across the road. A single yellow line denotes no parking. Speed limits throughout the island is 35 mph (20 mph). Do not speed and do not keep looking behind you.

MOTOR SCOOTERS

For hire at liveries throughout the island and through your hotel or guest house - visitors must be 18 years or older to drive. Law requires all persons (driver and passenger) riding motorized cycles to wear safety helmets. It is always wise to book cycles when not riding them.

ROUNDABOUTS

Motor cycles are required to park in marked cycle bays.

TRAFFIC LIGHTS IN THE CITY OF HAMILTON

At most intersections where there are traffic lights, pedestrians do not have the right of way on the crossing except when the green pedestrian light is showing. Pedestrian must push button on light pole for pedestrian green light for the convenience of the blind, a bell will ring when the pedestrian light turns green. At other pedestrian crossings throughout the island (marked by zebra stripes across the road), pedestrians do have the right of way and motorized traffic must stop in deference to pedestrians.
