

The present contract is concluded between:

- EUROCONSULTANTS, INC. 1455 Pennsylvania Avenue N.W., Suite 1180, Washington, D.C. 20004, represented by Mr. Ralph ICHTER, Chairman,

and

- Centre National pour la Promotion des Produits Agricoles et Alimentaires, 4 Rue Treilhard 75008 PARIS, FRANCE hereinafter referred to as C.N.P.A., represented by Mr. Pierre FAUCONNET, Chairman of C.N.P.A.

The C.N.P.A. is a non-profit trade association, grouping all major agricultural and food processing organizations of France. Its task is to promote agricultural and food exports from France to the rest of the world through generic export assistance programs and other appropriate means. It is also entrusted with the representation of broad French agricultural interests and informs its members of all policy development internationally which could impact their interest in the global market place. The C.N.P.A. is comprised of the following trade organizations, which fund its activities:

- L'association Nationale des Industries Agro-Alimentaires (ANIA)
- L'assemblee Permanente des Chambres d'Agriculture (APCA)
- L'assemblee Permanente des Chambres de Commerce et d'Industrie (APCCI)
- Le Centre National des Jeunes Agriculteurs (CNJA)
- La Confederation Francaise de la Cooperation Agricole (CFCA)
- La Confederation Nationale de la Mutualite, de la Cooperation et du Credit Agricoles (CNMCCA)
- Le Conseil National du Patronat Francais (CNPF)
- La Federation Nationale des Syndicats d'Exploitants Agricoles (FNSEA)

**Article 1**

EUROCONSULTANTS, INC. will provide C.N.P.A. with consulting services on broad agricultural and trade related policy developments in the United States.

**Article 2**

EUROCONSULTANTS, INC. services will cover all agricultural policies and products, with an emphasis on the oilseed sector.

It is understood by the two parties that this coverage does not include the dairy and wine industries' associations of France, represented by the Centre National Interprofessionnel de l'Economie Laitiere (C.N.I.E.L.) and the Federation of Wine and Spirit Exporters (F.E.U.S.).

### Article 3

In addition to any specific task assigned by C.N.P.A. to EUROCONSULTANTS, INC., EUROCONSULTANTS shall keep C.N.P.A. informed of developments on U.S. agricultural policies and trade-related matters, such as the URUGUAY ROUND of Negotiations on Agriculture. EUROCONSULTANTS, INC. will provide C.N.P.A. with a monthly report regarding the above-mentioned subjects.

It is understood between the two parties that C.N.P.A. or any of its members might request specific tasks, such as arranging meetings and contacts with U.S. policy-makers or trade organizations, as deemed necessary.

### Article 4

Any tasks performed by EUROCONSULTANTS, INC. on behalf of an individual company belonging to the founding trade associations will be invoiced by EUROCONSULTANTS, INC. separately, from the present contract.

### Article 5

Mr. Ralph ICHTER will personally devote his time to serve C.N.P.A.'s needs, as defined in the present agreement. In the interest of his commitments to C.N.P.A., he will not represent in the United States any interests which would be deemed in conflict with the interests of C.N.P.A. or its members.

### Article 6

In consideration for the services rendered under the present agreement, C.N.P.A. will pay EUROCONSULTANTS, INC. an annual fee, not to exceed the sum of 168 000 USD, including all expenses and costs incurred on C.N.P.A.'s behalf.

Payments will be made on a quarterly basis, as agreed upon by the two parties.

### Article 7

EUROCONSULTANTS, INC. shall provide C.N.P.A. with all information necessary to the completion of this agreement. It will also submit on a regular basis a financial statement summarizing expenses incurred on behalf of C.N.P.A. and agrees to submit any relevant financial information to C.N.P.A. if requested.

**Article 8**

The present contract is concluded for a period of one year, beginning of February 19th, 1990. It is understood that it can be extended after the first year by mutual agreement between the two parties.

**Article 9**

In the case of non-performance of part or all of the actions and obligations set forth in this agreement, the present contract will be terminated and EUROCONSULTANTS, INC. is obligated to reimburse C.N.P.A. on a pro-rated time basis for any subs advanced by C.N.P.A. under the quarterly payment plan.
