

Privacy Act Statement. 

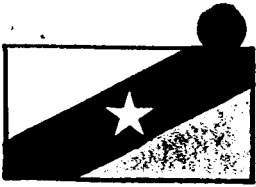
