

Privacy Act Statement. 

¹Political activity as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act means the dissemination of political propaganda and any other activity which the person engaging therein believes will, or which he intends to, prevail upon, indoctrinate, convert, induce, persuade, or in any other way influence any agency or official of the Government of the United States or any section of the public within the United States with reference to formulating, adopting, or changing the domestic or foreign policies of the United States or with reference to the political or public interests, policies, or relations of a government of a foreign country or a foreign political party.

CONTRACT


The Embassy of Japan, 2520 Massachusetts Avenue, NW, Washington, D.C. 20008 (hereinafter referred to as the "Embassy") and Walter H. Evans III, Suite 800, 2300 M Street, NW, Washington, D.C. (hereinafter referred to as "Evans"), have agreed as follows:

1. Evans shall provide the Embassy with counseling on legal matters and international economic issues as well as such matters as the Embassy will request.
2. The Embassy shall pay the amount of U.S. \$20,000 (Twenty Thousand Dollars) as an annual retainer for the period April 1, 1990 through March 31, 1991.
3. This contract shall come in force as of the first day of April, 1990 and shall be in effect until March 31, 1991, on the condition that the Diet approves the budget of fiscal year 1990 in addition to the already approved provisional budget.

In witness to the above agreement, Mr. Issei Nomura, representing the Embassy of Japan, and Mr. Walter H. Evans III, have signed hereunder.
