

Privacy Act Statement. Every registration statement, short form registration statement, supplemental statement, exhibit, amendment, dissemination report, copy of political propaganda or other document or information filed with the Attorney General under this act is a public record open to public examination, inspection and copying during the posted business hours of the Registration Unit in Washington, D.C. One copy is automatically provided to the Secretary of State pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Act, and copies of such documents are routinely made available to other agencies, departments and Congress pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Act. Finally, the Attorney General transmits an annual report to the Congress on the Administration of the Act which lists the names of all agents and the nature, sources and content of the political propaganda disseminated or distributed by them. This report is available to the public.

Public reporting burden for this collection of information is estimated to average .49 hours per response, including the time for reviewing instructions, searching existing data sources, gathering and maintaining the data needed, and completing and reviewing the collection of information. Registrant provides legal counsel to Embassy, primarily to Economic Section diplomats. Issues of bilateral economic relations between Japan and United States are the focus of registrant's work. Meetings with diplomats at Embassy, meetings with visiting diplomats from Foreign Ministry in Tokyo, preparation of legal memoranda initiated by registrant or in response to request or question from Embassy diplomat, and numerous telephone calls constitute the bulk of registrant's work.

5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.



CONTRACT


The Embassy of Japan, 2520 Massachusetts Avenue, NW, Washington, D.C. 20008 (hereinafter referred to as the "Embassy") and Walter H. Evans III, Davis Wright Tremaine, Suite 600, 701 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, Washington, D.C. 20004-2608 (hereinafter referred to as "Evans"), hereby agree as follows:

1. Evans shall provide the Embassy with counseling on legal matters and international economic issues, as well as such matters as the Embassy will request.
2. The Embassy shall pay an annual rate of U.S. \$20,000 (Twenty Thousand Dollars) as an annual retainer for the period April 1, 1991 through March 31, 1992.
3. This contract shall come in force as of the first day of April, 1991, and shall be in effect until March 31, 1992, on the condition that the Diet approves the budget of fiscal year 1991.
