

Privacy Act Statement. 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Dear Mr. Ambassador:

First, I look forward to a productive working relationship with you in representing the Embassy of Qatar.

Second, as a result of our discussions and in response to your request, I can summarize my responsibilities as follows:

- a. Provide general legal services to the Embassy on policy matters or legal issues as may arise;
- b. Provide analysis of proposed legislation that could affect Qatar directly or OPEC countries in general;
- c. Provide written memoranda or oral briefings on issues of interest to your government, including, but not limited to, regulation of foreign investment in the U.S., restrictions on foreign banking, access to U.S. markets of low transfer-price foreign chemicals, and aspects of U.S. international and financial policies;
- d. Interpret regulatory and administrative decisions or rules with an impact on Qatar; and
- e. Assist in whatever additional areas you and I agree upon at a future time.

Third, as we agreed, my fee for these professional services will be \$36,000 annually, payable at the rate of \$3000 monthly.


Fourth, this copy of the letter agreement is yours to sign and keep for your files. Will you please sign the attached copy and return it to me for my files.
