

Privacy Act Statement. This report is available to the public.





Dear Mr. Shin:

This letter is to set forth the agreement concerning the retention of Barron·Birrell, Inc., hereafter, (the firm), by Hyundai Washington Office, hereafter, (Hyundai), to provide public and media relations consulting services and such other matters as shall be referred to the firm from time-to-time by Hyundai.




