While performing arts have traditionally been dominant, recent years have witnessed Monaco's position in the modern art scene rise in prominence. With comprehensive offerings that include everything from pioneering new artistic concepts to world-famous cultural institutions, the principality is now attracting many young creators and contemporary artists. With its dazzling Mediterranean location, Monaco is also an ideal setting for cultural institutions and events held throughout the year.

This curated guide outlines the must-visit museums, galleries, and performing arts venues that contribute to the destination's flourishing arts and culture scenes.

See treasures and masterpieces in museums and galleries

Monaco may be known worldwide for its glamour, but its true essence as an extraordinary travel destination is thanks to its fascinating history. That's evident in its diverse selection of museums dedicated to everything from art and the sea to even vintage cars and collectibles. Explore these museums to learn more about what makes the principality so unique:

Classic Cars Collection of H.S.H. the Prince of Monaco

Now located near the Formula 1 circuit at Port Hercule, the Classic Cars Collection of H.S.H. the Prince of Monaco showcases Prince Rainier III's private collection of vintage automobiles. The museum, which features around 70 vintage automobiles, including racing cars from the Monte-Carlo Rally and F1 cars from the Monaco Grand Prix, offers visitors a journey through the history of automotive design and engineering.

Oceanographic Museum

Conceived by Prince Albert I over a century ago, the [Oceanographic Museum](#) lies inside a striking Baroque Revival building built on the side of the mythical Rock of Monaco. The museum offers educational exhibits, breathtaking ocean views, and an exploration of marine science history, showcasing over 6,000 different specimens.

Nouveau Musée National de Monaco

The Monegasque State's acquisition of two 19th-century villas—[Villa Paloma](#) and [Villa Sauber](#)—allowed for a museum that now regularly presents high-caliber exhibitions. Art lovers will appreciate the focus on contemporary works. It features rotating avant-garde exhibitions mixed with its expanding permanent collection as well as selected pieces from private collectors and prestigious museums.



Museum of Prehistoric Anthropology

Unearth the mysteries of Monaco's prehistoric past at the [Museum of Prehistoric Anthropology](#), which houses fossils and excavated artifacts that date to ancient times. The collections, founded by Prince Albert I in 1902, represent the different stages of regional prehistory and protohistory, as most archaeological and paleontological pieces come from the Principality, France, and Italy.

Museum of Stamps and Coins

Delve into the art of numismatics and philately at the [Museum of Stamps and Coins](#) which showcases the Principality's history through its currency, stamps, and rare collectibles. Find an extensive collection of Monegasque currency since 1640, rare stamps, and historical documents related to stamp printing from 1885 onwards, making it an excellent destination for history buffs and collectors.

Les Grands Appartements du Palais



Step into the opulent world of Monaco's royal history by visiting the [Prince's Palace](#). Built in the 13th century with elements from the Renaissance, it opens its luxurious private residences to visitors for part of the year. Admire the palace's splendor through various rooms, chambers, paintings, tapestries, and furniture. Some of the colorful frescoes were unveiled just last year.

Hauser & Wirth

Explore the [Hauser & Wirth](#) gallery at One Monte Carlo and experience art in the heart of Monaco, near the Hôtel de Paris. The space features 30-foot-high walls and hosts diverse exhibitions and events, including the current show, Mark Bradford's *Nobody Knows the Trouble I've Seen*, until April 27, 2024. Admission is free, and appointments are not required.

Almine Rech

Founded in Paris in 1989 with a James Turrell exhibition, this renowned gallery is known for showcasing minimal, perceptual, and conceptual art by world-famous artists. It has locations in cities around the world, and, most recently, in Monaco, where [the branch](#) welcomes visitors by appointment.



Espace 22

Discover the thriving contemporary art scene in Monaco at [Espace 22](#). The venue offers young contemporary artists a chance to show their work alongside renowned names and brands through temporary exhibitions, all in a prime location in the heart of Monte-Carlo.

Moretti Gallery

Established in 1999 by Fabrizio Moretti in Florence, this gallery specializes in Italian Old Masters paintings and has a flagship location in London. [The Monaco outpost](#) was born out of the country's commitment to arts and culture and features a modern gallery and exhibition space at Park Palace in Monte Carlo, overlooking the Place du Casino.

Francis Bacon MB Art Foundation



With 3,500 items, this [non-profit institution's](#) collection includes the artist's early paintings and furniture, extensive photographs, and an archive. Free guided tours, available by appointment every Tuesday and the first Saturday of each month, last 90 minutes and delve into Bacon's life, offering insights into his life, work, and creative process.

Rainier III Sculpture Trail

[This open-air museum](#) was introduced as part of the recent centennial commemorations for Prince Rainier III and features more than 200 sculptures acquired during his reign, including works by renowned artists like César, Arman, and Anish Kapoor. The trail, inaugurated last year, offers a QR code-based interactive experience, guiding visitors through the different neighborhoods of Monte-Carlo.

Enjoy transcendent performances

In Monaco, culture and the arts are integral to everyday life—vibrant dance and classical music performances reflect a Monegasque heritage that dates to the Belle Époque of the late 19th century. Enhance your visit with performances from these organizations, where a cultural symphony awaits.

Ballets de Monte-Carlo



This beloved dance company performs at Monaco's Grimaldi Forum and tours globally. Established in 1909 and currently led by Jean-Christophe Maillot, the **Ballets de Monte-Carlo** encompasses an elite ballet company, a dance festival, and the prestigious Princess Grace Academy.

Monte-Carlo Opera

Opera productions shine at Salle Garnier, a grand Italian-style theater within Monaco's iconic Casino de Monte-Carlo. Its excellent acoustics make it a prime venue for unforgettable performances by renowned musicians across genres.

Monte-Carlo Philharmonic Orchestra

Experience the enchantment of **summer concerts** at the Prince's Palace in the Cour d'Honneur, surrounded by Italian Renaissance frescoes. Launched in 1959 during Prince Rainier III's reign, this tradition harkens back to an 18th-century royal tradition of patronage for arts and music. Over the years, these performances, featuring major symphonic works, rare contemporary pieces, and innovative lyric and choreographic creations, have elevated the Monte-Carlo Philharmonic to a leading position among Europe's symphony orchestras.



Théâtre Princesse Grace

Built in the 1930s as Théâtre des Beaux-Arts and renamed **Théâtre Princesse Grace** in 1981, this iconic venue has been a Monaco landmark for almost a century. Renovated in the late 1970s under Princess Grace's guidance, it hosts renowned actors and emerging talents. (Pro tip: Most performances here are in French.)

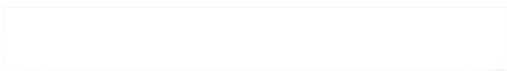

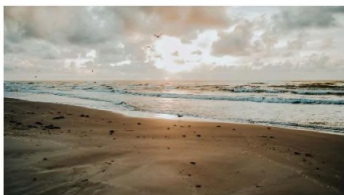

How to Go Off the Beaten Path in Monaco

Look beyond the glittering façade of casinos and sports cars to uncover the country's true essence.

Monaco, often associated with decadence, has many charms that often go unnoticed amid the rush toward the casinos and luxury yachts of Monte-Carlo, the destination's most famous district. A closer look at this coastal enclave on the Mediterranean reveals more than its contemporary image would suggest. Neither distinctly French nor entirely Italian, this country encompassing less than one square mile is a place of intriguing complexity, urging visitors to stay and explore rather than merely pass through.

Visiting the country's lesser-known areas—bustling markets, tranquil gardens, and architectural treasures—reveals the principality's diverse cultural mosaic, exposing a deeper, more multicultural identity. Monaco is home to 139 nationalities and has its own unique language, Mûnegu, a blend of Ligurian, French, Provençal, and Spanish. This intriguing mix adds layers to Monaco's culture and venturing off the beaten path yields a richer, more authentic experience.

Eat and drink in the La Condamine District

To experience the traditional Monaco, explore the vibrant spirit of La Condamine. Its architectural style, characterized by arcades and colorful building façades, mirrors the typical style of the French Riviera. Stop at the market on the Place d'Armes, which also features café terraces and newspaper stands. Discover around 20 stalls in the market halls, offering regional produce and other specialties from Monaco, Italy, and beyond. Open daily, it also hosts traders, market gardeners, and florists. Don't leave without trying some Monegasque specialties like socca, a kind of crepe made with chickpea flour.

Leave time to stop at La Distillerie de Monaco, the principality's first and only distillery. It specializes in artisanal liqueurs like L'Orangerie, made using locally grown oranges. Enjoy it chilled, over ice, or mixed with prosecco for a refreshing Monaco spritz.

Walk through the Old Town

Discover the **Old Town**, the historic district perched atop the famous Rock of Monaco, surrounded by views of the Mediterranean Sea. It's the location of the Grimaldi family's residence, the 13th-century **Prince's Palace**, now open after recent renovations. Begin at the Place du Palais to watch the **Changing of the Palace Guard**—this synchronized military spectacle of precision and solemnity occurs daily at 11:55 a.m.

Stroll the narrow medieval lanes, making your way to the **Club Bouliste Monégasque**. Tucked away near the **Oceanographic Museum**, this unassuming restaurant offers genuine local dishes. You can sample traditional delights including barbajuans, a ravioli-like fritter filled with Swiss chard. It's open to the public daily, even if you don't play pétanque, and it's the perfect way to savor some local culinary specialties.

The **Saint-Martin Gardens**, Monaco's inaugural public garden since 1816, showcases Mediterranean flora and exotic species along steep, winding paths close to the palace. This green oasis offers several serene resting spots to take in the panoramic sea views.

Next door, find the **Cathedral of Monaco**, the eternal resting place of Prince Rainier III and Princess Grace. Constructed in 1875 using limestone from La Turbie in southeastern France, this Roman-Byzantine masterpiece houses the tombs of former Princes, elegant artworks, and a retable by French painter Louis Bréa from 1500.

Experience the green spaces of Fontvieille

Fontvieille, Monaco's westernmost district, is a comparatively recent addition to the principality compared to others. It was predominantly built on reclaimed land based on the design by Italian engineer Gianfranco Giardini, making it one of the newer neighborhoods in Monaco. With its picturesque port adorned with boats and waterfront restaurants, Fontvieille invites strolls against the backdrop of The Old Town's majestic cliffs.

A visit to Fontvieille is not complete without a stop at the **Princess Grace Rose Garden**. Conceived by Prince Rainier III in honor of his wife, this English-style garden also features olive trees and more than 315 varieties of roses. Then, discover the outdoor art gallery of the **Fontvieille Sculpture Trail**; the pedestrian path encourages exploration of works by renowned artists like Rodin, Bourdelle, Léger, and more.

Hit the beach in the Larvotto District

Beach lovers should make it a priority to visit [Larvotto](#), part of Monte Carlo and located in the easternmost part of the principality. But first, explore the area around the Grimaldi Forum, the principality's main convention and cultural center. Next, wander the tranquil [Japanese Garden](#), designed by Yasuo Beppu, admiring the bamboo hedges, imported stones, meticulously pruned plants, and Zen features like ponds, waterfalls, and a tea house. Watch koi gracefully swim amid water lilies.

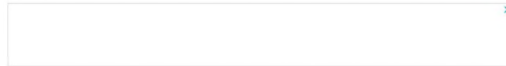
Larvotto is also where you'll find [Villa Sauber](#), an architectural gem from the Belle Époque. It was acquired by painter Robert Sauber in 1904, but its exact construction date remains a mystery. Under the ownership of the Monegasque State, it now hosts contemporary art exhibitions as part of the New National Museum.

Finally, enjoy the enchanting Larvotto Beach on Avenue Princesse Grace. This lovely seaside spot, which was recently renovated, features a shaded promenade and revamped beaches. Bask in the sun and dip your toes in the refreshing Mediterranean at one of the four private beaches: La Rose des Vents, Le Neptune, La Note Bleue, or Le Miami. Or enjoy ice cream from the Mullet parlor and savor it in the cool shade beneath swaying palm trees.

Admire architecture in the Exotic Garden District

Where the Alps meet the Mediterranean, find the [Exotic Garden](#) of Monaco, a more than 49,000-square-foot botanical garden clinging to a rocky cliffside. It's known for its terraced gardens, Mediterranean views, and various succulents, including around a thousand cacti.

Next, head to [Villa Paloma](#), a modern cultural center with lively art exhibitions that are now part of the New National Museum of Monaco. The exhibits inside the 19th-century villa blend contemporary creativity with fascinating history and beautiful gardens, offering an engaging experience for art enthusiasts.



Conclude your architectural exploration with a stroll westward along Boulevard du Jardin Exotique. The Simona Building, constructed in 2012 by architect Jean-Pierre Lott, has several distinctive features like green walls and a blend of vertical lines and curves using glass and metal. Nearby, Villa Troglodyte, also designed by Lott, ingeniously integrates a luxury home into a rocky promontory with minimal disturbance to the surroundings. Continue west to Villa Ispahan, distinguished by its Persian-style facade adorned with colored stained-glass windows and marble mosaics, and then ponder how these structures offer a glimpse into the principality's hidden heritage.

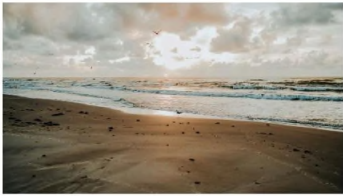

How to spend the sunny season on the French Riviera.

Everything feels grand in [Monaco](#), the world's second-smallest country. Tucked between limestone cliffs and the glittering Mediterranean Sea on the French Riviera, the petite principality attracts travelers from around the globe, who come to experience some of Europe's best dining, shopping, and entertainment, found within the gilded interiors of the Monte-Carlo Casino and along the twinkling streets of Monaco City.

Come summer, Monaco really leans into its allure, with a packed concert and events calendar, buzzy alfresco restaurants and bars, gardens bursting with color, and chill beach clubs pouring made-to-order Grand Prix cocktails. Pack the sunscreen and designer linens and read on for our favorite ways to soak up the season in Monaco.

Take a dip in the Mediterranean Sea.

With warm temperatures guaranteed and the sapphire Mediterranean never far from view, hanging out near the water is de rigueur in Monaco. Spend the day exploring the rocky coastline on a chartered yacht, or lounge by the Olympic-size pool at the 40-room [Monte-Carlo Beach](#) hotel, one of the only properties in Monaco with its own private beach. (Pro tip: Ask your Virtuoso travel advisor to reserve one of the chic striped cabanas.) The hotel's water-sports club offers paddleboat, stand-up paddleboard, and kayak rentals as well.

Explore Monaco's rocky coastline and the French Riviera's surrounding islands on a Jet Ski tour to the nearby French town of Menton, or board a yacht in search of bottlenose dolphins, fin whales, and monk seals in the Pelagos Sanctuary, a 33,000-square-mile marine protected area off the shores of France, Italy, and Monaco.

Larvotto Beach, a public strip of fine pebbles backed by a pedestrian-friendly promenade lined with beach clubs and restaurants, is popular for morning coffee, lunch by the sea, or an all-day session in the sun. Don't miss [La Note Bleue](#), a breezy restaurant with live music every Friday and Saturday in the evenings, that keeps the party going past sundown.

Dine at Michelin-starred restaurants.

Monaco plays host to some of the world's top chefs, who infuse their dishes with the local abundance of hyperfresh ingredients. The shining jewel in Monaco's culinary scene is Alain Ducasse's decadent, three-Michelin-starred [Louis XV](#) at the 207-room [Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo](#). There, Ducasse protégé chef Emmanuel Pilon showcases his years of experience in French kitchens through dishes such as marinated *gamberoni* (king prawns) with saffron rock fish gelée and caviar, and red mullet served with white asparagus, kiwi, and lemon leaves.

Virtuoso travel advisor Tiffany Layne ate her most memorable meal in Monaco at Les Ambassadeurs, inside the 125-room [Hotel Metropole Monte-Carlo](#). With chef Christophe Cussac at its helm, the two-Michelin-starred restaurant specializes in modern Mediterranean cuisine, such as sweet langoustine tails and green beans in a *maltaise* (blood-orange hollandaise) sauce. Not to be missed are the restaurant's impeccable bread and dessert trolleys. A bonus: "The private chef's table had a view of the kitchen," Layne says.

The Italian Mediterranean, dinner-turned-party [Sass' Café](#) beckons, known for its cozy baroque design, eccentric DJ sets, and celebrity sightings. Meanwhile, the daily Condamine Market caters to the Monégasque looking to procure fresh produce and a snack of *barbagiuan*, a savory fritter filled with Swiss chard and ricotta that's a national specialty. At the low-key oyster bar [Les Perles de Monte-Carlo](#), located on a pier in the Port de Fontvieille, travelers enjoy salmon, wild prawns, and ceviche with views of the Monaco Cathedral and the [Oceanographic Museum](#). "Order a seafood platter for everyone to share, and you can spend an entire afternoon as the locals do," says Virtuoso travel advisor Nick Moran.

Be sure to ask your Virtuoso advisor to book a table this summer at [Amazónico](#), one of Monaco's newest restaurants, which opens in April on the rooftop of the recently refurbished 150-year-old [Café de Paris Monte-Carlo](#) on the Place du Casino. Expect tropical, rain-forest-meets-Med decor and a menu of fresh seafood, fish, and grilled meats, similar to the brand's outposts in Dubai and London. In July, the 278-room [Hôtel Hermitage Monte-Carlo](#) will open its new Japanese restaurant, L'Abyssé Monte-Carlo, with French chef Yannick Alléno and sushi chef Yasunari Okazaki at its helm.

Stroll like a royal through Monaco's gardens.

For such a small country, Monaco bursts with abundant green space and blooming gardens, including the Saint Martin Gardens between the Oceanographic Museum and the Romanesque-style Monaco Cathedral. Its winding paths are lined with plants and flowers, notable sculptures such as a bronze statue of Prince Albert I, and tucked-away benches with mesmerizing sea views. Bring your phone along to the Princess Grace Rose Garden, not just for the photo ops, but also to scan the QR codes on the plaques throughout to learn more about the statues and floral varieties.

"There are thousands of rose bushes and hundreds of varieties, including one called Princesse de Monaco, named for Grace Kelly, the late Princess of Monaco," says Virtuoso travel advisor Lynda Zuber. "It's a nice respite from Monaco's bustle."

For another moment of zen, head to Monaco's serene Japanese Garden, tucked between the casino and Larvotto Beach. A mix of Japanese and Mediterranean plant varieties fill the space, which is also adorned with lanterns, arched bridges, koi- and lotus-flower-filled ponds, and a ceremonial teahouse.

Embrace these only-in-Monaco experiences.

While the [Monaco Grand Prix](#), held every May, holds the marquee spot on the principality's event calendar, the celebrations and special events continue well into the summer. In June and July, the hugely popular Monte-Carlo Summer Festival brings dance and 80s pop artists such as Air and Vivien Savage to different venues throughout the principality, including the Opéra Garnier Monte-Carlo and the Salle des Etoiles.

Atop "The Rock," a promontory above Monaco's harbors and narrow-laned Monaco-Ville (Old Town), travelers will find the Prince's Palace, the official residence of the Grimaldi royal family for nearly 800 years. The Changing of the Guards takes place every morning, rain or shine, at 11:55, but in the summer, the palace opens its doors for [under-the-stars concerts](#) by the Monte-Carlo Philharmonic Orchestra in its royal courtyard.



Better yet, "take one from the Nice Airport to Monaco," he says. "It's a terrific value that doubles as an exciting arrival experience."

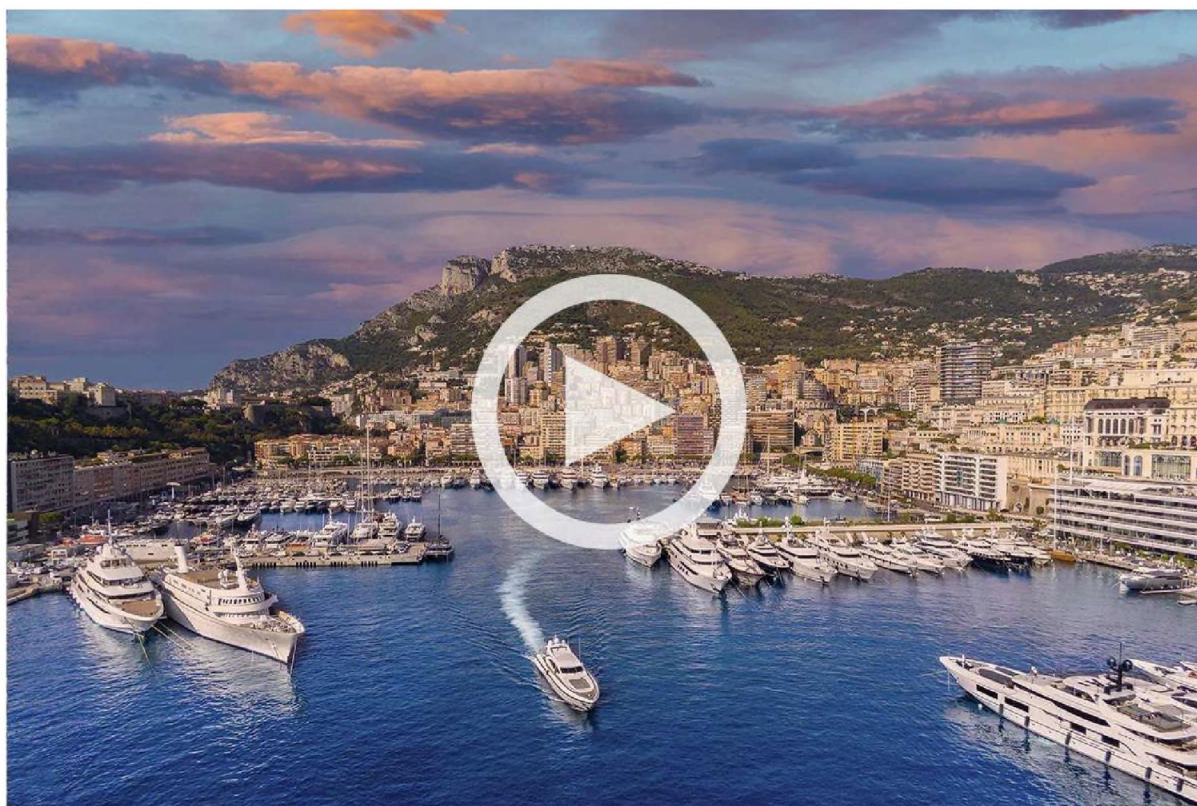

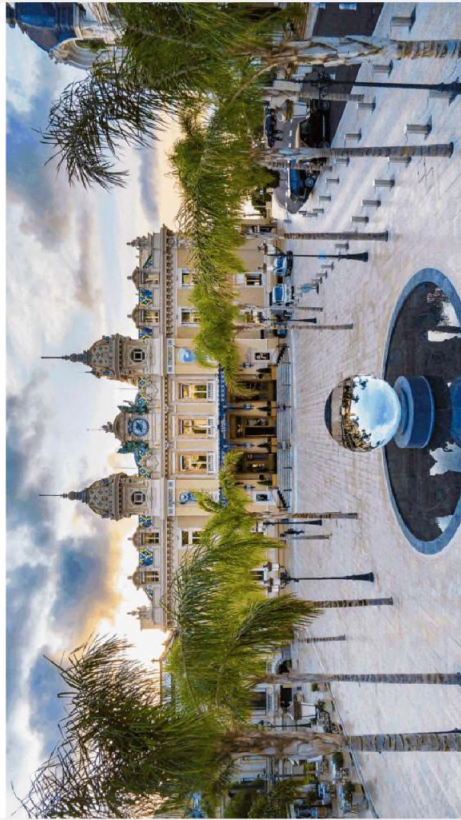
