CONSULTANCY AGREEMENT

By the signatures of their directors affixed below, ELTAC, European Largest Textile and Clothing Companies, and EuroStrategy Associates, Inc., enter this day into an agreement whereby the latter provides the former with international public affairs and communications counsel. Terms and conditions of this agreement are as follows:


1. EuroStrategy Associates, Inc. shall make available to ELTAC the professional advice and counsel of Senior Consultants Seth Goldschlager and David Morey on the basis of one and one half days per month each.

2. In exchange, ELTAC agrees to pay EuroStrategy Associates, Inc. professional fees of Twenty Thousand French Francs per month on the first of each month. Such amounts shall be in the form of wire transfers to EuroStrategy Associates, Inc.*

3. At the end of each month, EuroStrategy Associates Inc. shall provide an accounting of reasonable business expenses which shall promptly be reimbursed by ELTAC. The undertaking of substantial expenses shall be approved in advance by ELTAC.

4. Also, at the end of each month, EuroStrategy Associates shall provide an accounting of professional consultancy time spent over and above the one and one-half days for each Senior Consultant. Such additional time shall have been, insofar as possible, the subject of prior agreement by ELTAC and shall be billed at the rate of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Francs per day.

5. This agreement shall be in force until December 31, 1992 and shall be renewed automatically for one additional year at the end of each year unless either party gives notice of intended discontinuance by the First day of October of the then-current year.
