

Privacy Act Statement. Finally, the Attorney General transmits an annual report to the Congress on the Administration of the Act which lists the names of all agents and the nature, sources and content of the political propaganda disseminated or distributed by them. This report is available to the public.



1. Conducting investigations of, and seeking to obtain legal access to, two individuals in the United States who are under the Justice Department's witness protection program and who have made certain allegations that Senator Andreotti engaged in criminal conduct in Italy.

2. Preparing editorial pieces, giving interviews, appearing on radio and/or TV talk shows, and other methods of presenting information to the U.S. public, and enlisting other U.S. persons to do the same, for the purpose of protecting and restoring the reputation of Senator Andreotti in the United States and in Italy.



- (1) uncovering as much as possible about the witnesses in the U.S., including issues relating to their credibility;
- (2) preparing an explanation of your position in English so that we can get your story out in the U.S. media; and
- (3) encouraging prominent Americans to speak out in your behalf of the basis of the explanation we provide.




