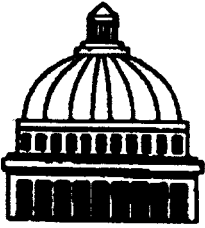

Dear Mr. Koncz,

Thank you for your fax letter of March 8 ordering our services to carry out a Washington visitation program on April 12, 1996 for Mr. Janos Eros, chief executive officer of the Commercial and Credit Bank. This letter is to set forth the scope, terms and conditions of our working relationship.

SCOPE OF WORK

The Franklin Firm (hereinafter "TFF"), our public relations division, will plan and implement a schedule along the lines of those outlined in your fax letter of March 8, 1996, allowing for adjustments as circumstances require.

In addition to arranging meetings in Washington, TFF will assign an executive to accompany Mr. Eros to the meetings and will arrange for all local transportation, from arrival on April 11 to departure the evening of April 12. TFF will also arrange for transportation in New York City on April 11, picking up Mr. Eros at his last meeting there and taking him to his air or train connection. TFF will make the necessary travel arrangements to Washington, as well.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

For its professional services, TFF will be paid US\$6,800.00 by DMT. TFF's engagement by DMT will commence upon our receipt of a copy of this letter signed by DMT (a fax copy, followed by a signed original by mail will be satisfactory), and half of the professional services, US\$3,400.00 along with a deposit of US \$1000.00 against out-of-pocket expenses to be incurred on behalf of Mr. Eros's visit.
