I am very pleased to be able to continue the consulting arrangement with you into 1995. I look forward to working closely with you in the future.

This document, when countersigned by you, will constitute the agreement between the Board of Foreign Trade, Ministry of Economic Affairs (hereinafter referred to as "Board") and Dr. Gary Wasserman for reporting and informational services.


1. Dr. Wasserman will provide information, analysis and advice on likely developments in American economic, trade and political matters which are of interest to the Board.
2. Dr. Wasserman will recommend informational activities (briefings, visits, seminars, press releases, etc.) that will most effectively respond to these developments.
3. Dr. Wasserman will provide both oral and written briefings throughout the year on a regular basis and as requested by the Board.
4. In consideration of the aforementioned services provided to the Board by Dr. Wasserman, the Board agrees to pay Dr. Wasserman a fee of \$7,000.00 per month, payable at the beginning of each month.
5. The term of this agreement shall be from September 1, 1994, through August 31, 1995. The parties may agree to negotiate a new contract prior to the termination of this one.
6. All information provided to the Board by Dr. Wasserman during the course of this contract shall be for the use of the Board itself, and shall not be made public without the consent of Dr. Wasserman.
7. This agreement may be terminated by either the Board or Dr. Wasserman upon 90 days written notice to the other.
