RETAINER AGREEMENT

This agreement is made between JWI, L.L.C. doing business as Jefferson Waterman International (JWI), and Camelot Oil & Gas Development Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "CLIENT").

CLIENT and JWI have agreed that JWI shall provide strategic counsel, public affairs and related services to promote CLIENT's government relations in the Caspian Sea region and in the U.S.

The term of this Agreement is for six (6) months commencing 1 June 2005. This Agreement may be extended for additional 6-month periods if both parties so agree in writing.

CLIENT will pay to JWI a fee of \$US 2,000,000 (Two Million U.S. Dollars) for the initial 6-month term. The first installment for \$200,000 (Two Hundred Thousand US Dollars) is due 1 June 2005. Thereafter, payment will be in two phases:

1. 1 June - 30 August, 2005: CLIENT will pay to JWI \$121,739.00 (One Hundred Twenty One Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty Nine US Dollars) every fourteen (14) days.
2. 1 September - 30 November 2005: CLIENT will pay to JWI \$153,846.00 (One Hundred Fifty Three Thousand Eight Hundred Forty Six US Dollars) every 14 days.

CLIENT and JWI will review work progress on or about 1 September 2005, and decide together whether to continue activity or terminate this Agreement.




