Dear Mr. Waterman,

Pursuant to discussions with your representative, I hereby name Jefferson Waterman International as the sole advocacy group authorized to represent la Cote d'Ivoire in the United States of America until further notice and pending a detailed contract between your organization and my country.

I expect you to diligently pursue and enhance the full range of Ivorian national interests, as represented by my Presidency and by my government: economic and financial, military and security, trade and investment, public relations. The immediate goal is to marshal the maximum support from the U.S. Executive and Legislative branches, media, think tanks and NGOs. You will also undertake similar actions on our behalf vis a vis international financial institutions and international organizations. Upon my instruction, you may also undertake such actions outside the United States. Finally, I expect JWI to act both as a consultant and an advocate.

It is understood that compensation for these undertakings will await the full and effective establishment of my powers and those of my government, in accordance with the will of the Ivorian people and the international community. Such compensation will be set forth in the final contract under negotiation between my government and JWI, both for any expenses incurred by JWI in this interim period and for fees and expenses involved in the final contract.
