

REPRESENTATION AGREEMENT

between the Asociacion Hondurena de Maquiladores ("AHM") and Washington World Group, Ltd. ("WWG").

WHEREAS, AHM wishes to engage WWG's services to represent its interests in various areas on an interim basis until an agreement covering a longer period can be concluded; and WWG wishes to perform the desired services;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, and for other valuable consideration, the Parties do agree as follows:

1. Terms. This Representation Agreement shall become effective upon signature and shall continue for a period of three (3) weeks, through June 10, 1996.

2. Services to be Rendered. WWG shall represent AHM's interests in various matters, to include initiating an action program in Washington to influence opinion-shapers in the media and key decision-makers in the U.S. Government in order to safeguard Honduras's export processing zones and otherwise protect AHM's economic interests. In addition, WWG shall perform other services as may be agreed upon in furtherance of the above.

WWG shall plan, prepare for, and initiate a program for action that includes: (1) direct lobbying efforts with key Administration and Congressional officials to generate support for the Honduran private sector; (2) media and public relations efforts to generate favorable articles, stories, and editorials in the print media and radio/television and other electronic media, and to obtain support from respected individuals, think tanks, and foundations; and (3) legal actions to supplement the lobbying and public relations efforts and to ensure that all activities are focused on achieving the desired results in the most effective manner, with the appropriate expenditure of resources. If the Agreement is extended, the above-described activities will continue and future actions will be undertaken to promote the Honduran private sector and increasing trade and direct investment.

WWG shall coordinate all its activities with AHM and the Embassy of Honduras in Washington.

3. Compensation. WWG shall be paid a fee of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) for its services over the three week period. In addition to the fee for services, WWG shall be entitled to up to twenty five hundred dollars to cover normal

out-of-pocket expenses (\$2,500.00) incurred on behalf of AHM during the period. AHM shall pay this amount in advance, and WWG shall draw against such funds as actual expenses are incurred for AHM. Any balance remaining at the end of the period of this Agreement is for the account of AHM. Extraordinary expenses including out-of-town travel require specific approval and separate funding.

Work will begin on the project immediately upon receipt of seventeen thousand five hundred dollars (\$17,500.00) for WWG's fee and out-of-pocket expenses. The funds should be sent by wire-transfer to Washington World Group, Ltd.'s bank account number 17170874 at Riggs Bank, Lincoln Branch, 17th Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20036, ABA Routing Code 054000030.

4. Disclosure of Information. Each Party shall keep confidential any information that the other Party deems confidential in connection with this project.

5. Best Efforts. Both WWG and AHM shall use their best efforts in carrying out the services contemplated by this Agreement.

6. Entire Agreement. This Agreement contains the entire understanding and agreement between the Parties and cannot be amended, modified, or supplemented in any respect, except by a subsequent written Agreement entered into by both Parties.

7. Superseding Agreement. This Agreement supersedes and replaces any prior understanding, written or oral, between the Parties, relating to the services described herein.
