

Privacy Act Statement. ¹Political activity as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act means the dissemination of political propaganda and any other activity which the person engaging therein believes will, or which he intends to, prevail upon, indoctrinate, convert, induce, persuade, or in any other way influence any agency or official of the Government of the United States or any section of the public within the United States with reference to formulating, adopting, or changing the domestic or foreign policies of the United States or with reference to the political or public interests, policies, or relations of a government of a foreign country or a foreign political party.

AGREEMENT

This **AGREEMENT**, by and between, the **GOVERNMENT OF ICELAND** (hereafter referred to as "GOI"), and **STEPHEN S. BOYNTON** (hereinafter referred to as "SSB", 1015 Moorefield Hill Grove, Vienna, Virginia 22180-6249, USA;

WHEREAS, the GOI is desirous of retaining the consulting services of Stephen S. Boynton on various matters related to its relationship with the United States; and

WHEREAS, SSB has, in the past, provided certain information, recommendations, and advice to personnel in the Foreign Ministry of Iceland, and has the background and experience to continue to provide counsel and advice to the GOI;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That SSB shall provide advice and counsel to the GOI on various matters, including, but not limited to, the security interest of Iceland as it relates to the United States as well as other issues and they may arise;

2. That SSB, when requested, shall schedule meetings with various members and staff of the Congress of the United States and Administration officials with representatives of the GOI.

3. That SSB shall report to personnel at the Embassy of Iceland located in Washington, D.C., as well as personnel at the Ministry for Foreign Affairs in Reykjavik, Iceland, if so required;

4. That SSB will provide information including reports, news articles, correspondence and other data on subjects of interest to GOI;

5. That GOI shall pay to SSB the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00 US) per month, said sum based upon an average of five (5) hours per month at two hundred dollars (\$200.00 US) per hour, it being understood that some months the hours SSB is engaged on the business of the GOI may be less or more, as need dictates;

6. That GOI shall pay said retainer by check each month and sent to the address of SSB noted above;

7. That it is understood that SSB will be available for travel when deemed appropriate and that the GOI shall reimburse SSB for the expenses associated with such travel;


8. That the GOI shall reimburse SSB for expenses associated with this **AGREEMENT** including postage, long distance telephone and facsimile costs; local travel (i.e., metro, taxi) and other such expenditures, it being understood that no expenditure shall be incurred over one hundred dollars (\$100.00 US) unless specifically authorized in writing by personnel of the GOI with the exception of the cost noted in paragraph 9 below;


9. That SSB, as required by the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended, and the regulations thereunder, shall register as a foreign agent and file the required documents with the office of the Attorney General of the U.S. Department of Justice and that the GOI shall reimburse SSB for the

filing fee of three hundred five dollars (\$305.00 US). [5 USC § 1003 *et. seq.*; 31 Fed. Reg. 13343 (October 14, 1966); 32 Fed. Reg. 6362 (April 22, 1967)]; and

10. That the AGREEMENT may be terminated by either party by written notice, said termination to be effective thirty (30) days from the date of such written notice.
