

I understand that your Comptroller has expressed some reservations about the method of billing proposed in my letter to you of March 22, 1965, insofar as matters other than the LTV litigation are concerned, and that he would prefer maintaining our retainer agreement for these matters with an increase in the sum to \$5000 per annum retroactive to January 1, 1965. We are agreeable to the Comptroller's proposal for 1965 subject to a review of the matter for future years in early 1966.
