Registrant acts as General Counsel for the French Supply Office, 1800 Massachusetts Avenue, Washington, D. C., an agency of the Government of the French Republic. In this capacity, partners and associates of the registrant furnish general legal advice to the French Supply Office in connection with its operations and with the procurement and related activities of the French purchasing missions in the United States, participate in the negotiation of contracts for the purchase of supplies, services and equipment through ordinary business channels from United States suppliers, assist in drafting and advise with respect to the legal aspects of procurement contracts, participate in negotiations arising out of controversies under such contracts and serve as counsel in connection with litigation or arbitration proceedings arising out of such controversies. In addition, partners of the registrant, from time to time as requested, advise the French Government in its relations with the Export-Import Bank and other departments and agencies of the United States Government in connection with financial and supply matters. Registrant performs legal and related services for the Chambers of Commerce of Venezuela in connection with opposing any legislation designed to restrict, tax, or impose quotas on the United States imports of petroleum and petroleum products. Advice to members of a Trade Mission from Venezuela to the First International Trade Fair at Chicago, Illinois from August 7-20, 1950, inclusive. The Mission consisted of representatives of private business organizations and of government agencies and had as its purpose the fostering of good trade relations between the United States and Venezuela.

Registrant engages in the general practice of law, representing corporate and private clients in New York, Washington and Paris.
