1. Government of the French Republic.

Registrant acts as General Counsel for the French Supply Office, 1800 Massachusetts Avenue, N.W., Washington, D. C., an agency of the Government of the French Republic. In this capacity, partners and associates of the registrant furnish general legal advice to the French Supply Office in connection with its operations and with the procurement and related activities of the French purchasing missions in the United States, participate in the negotiation of contracts for the purchase of supplies, services and equipment through ordinary business channels from U.S. suppliers, assist in drafting and advice with respect to the legal aspects of procurement contracts, participate in negotiations arising out of controversies under such contracts, and serve as counsel in connection with litigation or arbitration proceedings arising out of such controversies. In addition, partners of the registrant from time to time as requested, advise the French Government in its relations with the Export-Import Bank and other departments and agencies of the United States Government in connection with financial and supply matters.

Registrant acts as counsel to the French Financial Counselor, the French Commercial Counselor, and the French Financial Controller, who are representatives of the Government of the French Republic. In this capacity, partners and associates of the registrant give information and related advice to these officers with respect to American legislative proposals, and administrative regulations which affect French trade and French financial and commercial interests. Registrant also advises these officers with respect to procurement contracts.

Registrant also acts as counsel to the French Air, Naval and Military Attaches, who are officers of the Government of the French Republic. In this capacity, partners and associates of the registrant advise these officers with respect to procurement contracts and also with respect to leases, litigation, etc., in which these officers have an interest.

2. Chambers of Commerce of Venezuela.

Registrant performed legal and related services for the Chambers of Commerce of Venezuela. These services included giving information and related advice to the Chambers of Venezuela concerning any legislative or administrative proposals designed to increase tariffs or impose quotas on petroleum and petroleum products.

3. Conseil National du Patronat Francais.

Registrant gives information and related advice to the Patronat Francais (and, at its request, related associations such as Comite France Actuelle) concerning routine legal matters such as letters,

contracts, loans, as well as with respect to American legislative and administrative proposals, and communicates individually with other interested persons in the United States.

4. Comite Franc-Dollar.

Registrant gives information and related advice to the Comite Franc-Dollar with respect to legislative and administrative proposals and actions which affect trade between France and the United States, particularly French exports to this country.
