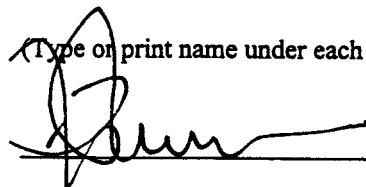

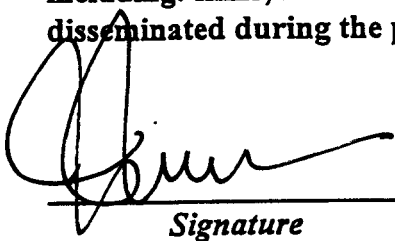

### **Avions de Transport Regional (ATR)**

Powell Tate was retained in November 1994, by ATR to provide strategic public affairs and communications counsel related to aircraft produced by the company and sold in the United States. Tasks have included development of fact sheets and other materials, dissemination of those materials in the United States, and ongoing liaison with the U.S. media on behalf of ATR.

### **Electronic Industries Association of Japan (EIAJ)**

Between January 1, 1998, and June 30, 1998, Powell Tate regularly updated and maintained the EIAJ Website. Weekly information requests were forwarded to EIAJ headquarters in New York and to Washington-based legal counsel. Powell Tate also monitored semiconductor media coverage through a daily clipping service.

### **Kingdom of Morocco**

During the reporting period, Powell Tate provided general public relations services, including strategic communications counsel, development of informational materials, monitoring news coverage of Morocco, and outreach to interested third parties.

### **MERHAV**

Between January 1, 1998, and June 30, 1998, Powell Tate assisted the MERHAV group of companies in a public relations campaign designed to generate media coverage around the U.S. visit of the President of Turkmenistan. As part of that campaign, Powell Tate worked closely with the Embassy of Turkmenistan to produce country information materials and build an updated media contact list. During the reporting period, Powell Tate has provided strategic communications counsel for SGS, including advice on working with the U.S. media and responding to media reports and inquiries about the company.

##### **Taiwan Research Institute**

During the reporting period, Powell Tate provided general public relations services for the Taiwan Research Institute, a non-profit policy research organization based in Taipei. In this capacity, Powell Tate provided TRI with ongoing strategic communications counsel; developed informational materials such as press releases and background papers; maintained an Internet site; communicated with foreign affairs reporters, editorial writers, and other journalists covering issues related to Taiwan; conducted outreach activities to interested third parties; monitored print and broadcast coverage of Taiwan; and collected new reports on economic and political issues related to Taiwan.
