In exchange, Patton Boggs L.L.P. agreed to pay me a fee of \$25,000.



This letter puts into writing the agreement we made over the phone earlier this week.

1. I will write the major speech that Turkish Prime Minister Mesut Yilmaz (“the Prime Minister”) expects to deliver before the Anti-Defamation League in New York City on December 17, 1997.
2. I will write the major speech that the Prime Minister expects to deliver before the American Turkish Council and the U.S. Chamber of Commerce in Washington, D.C. on December 18, 1997.
3. I will be responsible for any other speeches, remarks, and talking points the Prime Minister will need for all of his other public appearances during his visit to the United States from December 17 to December 20, 1997.
4. I will produce drafts of all products at a date agreed to by you, the Turkish Embassy, the Prime Minister’s office, and me.
5. For every written product, I will provide an unlimited number of rewrites, redraftings, or revisions as needed. You will determine when a draft is final.
6. I will offer strategic communications advice on the Prime Minister’s visit from today’s date until December 21, 1997.
7. During the Prime Minister’s visit, I will make myself available 24 hours a day every day for any speechwriting or communications advice that is necessary.



10. I acknowledge that in performing the above work, I am acting as an independent contractor and not as an employee of Patton, Boggs, and Blow.


