

Dear Mr. Airekat:

To follow up on our letter of May 15, 2009 and your subsequent discussions with Department representatives, I am pleased to confirm that the Department has no objection to your office referring to itself as "The General Delegation of the Palestine Liberation Organization (or PLO)" or to its public display of the Palestinian flag used by the PLO and Palestinian Authority. You may regard this letter as removing the restriction on public display of the Palestinian flag that were set forth in my letter of June 22, 1994 from the Director of the Office of Foreign Missions to Hasan Abdel Rahman.

The Department has approved these modifications in light of the ongoing cooperation between your office and the Department of State. Other than the lifting of the flag restriction, the Department's letter of June 22, 1994 continues to reflect the terms and conditions under which the office is authorized to operate in the United States. As such, these modifications do not confer diplomatic privileges and immunities and do not alter the status of the office which is not a diplomatic mission or embassy under the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, customary international law, or United States law.

We look forward to continuing our work with your office as we seek to broaden our relationship with the Palestinians and promote our shared goal of a comprehensive Middle East peace.
