

SKI FILMS

SKI TOURING IN NORWAY, 11 minutes, color and sound; scenes from Finse and Geilo on the Oslo-Bergen railroad; ski instruction and demonstration of the popular ski touring cult of Norwegians.

SPECIAL THEME FILMS

NORWEGIAN ARCHITECTURE & APPLIED ART, 19 minutes, color and sound; contemporary Norwegian architecture and design; tracing ties with traditional crafts with emphasis on today's achievements; visits to workshops of leading designers; samples of creative design in wood, ceramic, fabric, crystal, silver and inlaid enamel etc.

ANCIENT ART IN NORWAY, 20 minutes, color and sound; the animal motif in ancient Norwegian art is the main theme, displayed through stave churches with a profusion of wood carvings, and the ornamentation of well preserved objects excavated from Viking graves.

BIRD CLIFFS OF LOFOTEN, 20 minutes, color and sound; scenes from the magnificent bird cliffs in the Lofoten isles, situated beyond the Arctic Circle. The island of Røst alone provides shelter for at least 3 million puffins, 1 million kittiwakes and many other species, such as the rare stormy petrel and Arctic petrel etc.
