

The above agreement is for a period of six months, during which the registrant will provide public relations and related services for the foreign principal. The contract is for the amount of \$25,000.

8. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

The registrant will provide consultancy services to the Agent of the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina to the International Court of Justice (ICJ) in the matter between Bosnia and Serbia concerning acts of genocide committed against the people of Bosnia by forces under the control of the government of Serbia. The purpose will be to promote reconciliation in Bosnia by building support and understanding among elected and appointed officials and the general public in the United States concerning how the pursuit of the case and related actions by the government of Bosnia advance the objectives of the United States and its allies in policies in the Balkans.


The registrants will convey the importance of the ICJ case to the general public, elected officials, Congressional staff, and other officials, as well as the media and interested academics. The registrant will prepare informational materials. The registrant will also draft letters and possibly op-eds for signature and submission by the foreign principal, and will advise the foreign principal regarding participation in international meetings and related fora.

9. Will the activities on behalf of the above foreign principal include political activities as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act and in the footnote below? Yes No

If yes, describe all such political activities indicating, among other things, the relations, interests or policies to be influenced together with the means to be employed to achieve this purpose.

The Registrant will seek to influence the willingness of the United States to support and recognize the importance of the genocide case of Bosnia and Herzegovina against Serbia before the International Court of Justice.

To accomplish this objective, the registrant will assist the foreign principal in arranging meetings with U.S. government officials and with U.S. and European journalists and opinion-shapers. The registrant will also seek to make the American and European press aware of the case, its progress, and related details of the proceedings through the use of informational papers and other materials. The registered agent will not make any representations on behalf of the foreign principal directly to the public or to the media.
