Registrant will assist in the development, preparation and presentation of the position of the Government of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in an antidumping and countervailing duty case that is pending before the U.S. Department of Commerce in which claimants are seeking the imposition of duties on crude oil products of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia under the trade laws of the United States. Registrant will participate in meetings, discussions and other contacts to attempt to secure support for the position of the Government of Saudi Arabia in opposition to the imposition of such duties and in support of a finding that dumping has not occurred. From time to time registrant also may participate in other meetings, discussions or other contacts with government officials in which it would represent the interests of Saudi Aramco.
