

**Insert Page Attachment to Question #5 of the Amendment to its Supplemental Statement  
for the period ending April 30, 2002 filed by American Worldwide Inc.**

Section #11 of the filed supplemental statement should be amended to reflect only the following activities undertaken by persons at American Worldwide Inc. on behalf of the Republic of Angola. The original supplemental statement was inadvertently overbroad in that it described certain activities undertaken by consultants retained by American Worldwide Inc. who are fully disclosed in the supplemental statement.

“Assisted the Republic of Angola in preparations for the Washington visit by President Jose Eduardo dos Santos, including preparing for meetings with Congressional leaders and senior Administration officials. Continue to assist the Republic of Angola on issues before the Export-Import Bank of the United States, including meeting with EX-IM Bank officials. Advised the Republic of Angola Ministry of Geology and Mines about proposed Clean Diamond Trade Act. Advised the Ambassador from Angola on a variety of issues, such as the State Department’s Country Report on Human Rights. Arranged and attended meetings with U.S. Ambassador to Angola and State Department officials on Angola relations issues.”

Section #12 of the filed supplemental statement should be amended to reflect the following three contacts between persons at American Worldwide Inc. and agencies/officials of the United States.

“2/12/02      Lunch meeting in Angola with U.S. Ambassador Dell to discuss bilateral relations.

4/30/02      Meeting with Mark Bellamy and Len Kravitz of the State Department to discuss bilateral relations.

5/9/02      Meeting with Export-Import Bank of U.S. officials Robert Morin and Thomas Fitzpatrick to discuss Angolan financing and development issues.”
