**Serbian Foreign Minister Available for Interviews on Serbia's Role in European and Global Security**

June 26, 2024 -- Marko Djuric, Foreign Minister of Serbia, will be in Washington, D.C., during the NATO Summit from July 9-11 and is available for interviews beforehand to discuss Serbia's pivotal role in European and global security.

Minister Djuric is eager to discuss Serbia's ambitions for economic and infrastructural development as the largest country in the Western Balkans; Serbia's participation in NATO events and its contributions to UN and EU peacekeeping missions; Serbia's positioning as a potential hub at the crossroads of Europe; and its hosting of EXPO 2027.

**WHAT:** Minister Djuric is eager to discuss:

- The historical relationship between Serbia and the U.S., drawing on over 143 years of shared history.
- The importance of continuous exchanges between the U.S. and Serbian governments.
- Serbia's participation in NATO events and its neutral stance toward membership, along with the significance of its membership in the Partnership for Peace.
- Serbia's role in U.N. and E.U. peacekeeping missions and deployment alongside U.S. forces in the Multinational Forces and Observers mission in the Sinai.
- The crucial support of the U.S. in the Belgrade-Pristina Dialogue and NATO's role through KFOR.
