The purpose of this letter is to announce your appointment as the exclusive United States business liaison of the Korea Institute of Science and Technology ("KIST") for the Mid-Atlantic Region (the "Region") covering Delaware, the District of Columbia, Maryland, Virginia, New Jersey, New York and the United States (Federal) Government.

As you know, KIST founded in 1966 as Korea's first multi-disciplinary research institute with the goal to develop the national economy through science and technology. The institute provided an invaluable service in formulating long-term national policies and Korea's development programs. It has also played a leading role in high technology business development activities in the Republic of Korea. Among other things, our organization supports our domestic technology firms through business incubation and technology transfer initiatives. Under the terms of this appointment, KIST has authorized you as the sole point of contact operating within the Region to facilitate our activities in the United States by promoting our international cooperation, important work, and the-commercial opportunities for the technology firms we serve. Simply put, we are counting on you to identify opportunities for KIST to market appropriate technology products and services through networking events, trade shows, advertising venues and direct sales leads emanating in your Region.

The term of your appointment under this letter is five years unless you withdraw or KIST revokes it sooner with prior written notice. We understand that you may exercise the appointment made under this letter in any generally accepted legal manner, but are not required to devote any specific or minimal time to the same. We also agree that you have no right, power or authority to bind KIST in any way, and that your services under this appointment rendered only as an independent contractor of KIST.
