

AGREEMENT

This Agreement was made verbally on 15<sup>th</sup> of October 2004, between the Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office, Washington, D.C. (hereafter referred to as "TECRO") and Gregory H. Laughlin and RJI Government Strategies, Inc. and is signed today \_\_\_ December 2004.

The parties have agreed as follows:

1. The maintenance and continued growth of understanding and cooperation between the Republic of China (Taiwan) and the United States is in the interests of both countries.
2. To fulfill this important objective, Gregory H. Laughlin shall arrange a delegation of the U.S. House and Senate members to visit Taiwan by December 31, 2004. The participants of the delegation shall be approved by TECRO.
3. As compensation for this service, Gregory H. Laughlin and RJI Government Strategies, Inc. shall receive a fee of US \$ 25,000.00, payable when the mission is being carried out.
4. Gregory H. Laughlin shall carry out all of his activities within the framework of this agreement under the direction and supervision of TECRO.
5. In the course of its representation of TECRO, Gregory H. Laughlin agrees that he will act in conformance with all applicable United States laws and regulations.
6. Any reports prepared by Gregory H. Laughlin and RJI Government Strategies, Inc. shall be considered confidential and not for distribution to any third party. On request, Gregory H. Laughlin and RJI Government Strategies, Inc. will deliver all copies, in any form whatsoever, to TECRO.
7. Either party may terminate this contract on 60 days written notice for any reason.
