The nature and method of the Foreign Principal's performance of the above stated understanding will be to accept the Registrant as a nominee for the elected position as a member of the political party (Per L'Italia Nel Mondo Tremaglia). The nature and method of the Registrant's performance is based solely on the Registrant's seeking the elected office.

The registrant proposes to engage in campaigning for electoral votes so as to be elected to the sought after elected office. The elected office sought by the Registrant is a seat in the Senate of the Italian Republic whereby the Registrant will represent citizens of the Italian Republic who reside in North America and Central America.

Should the Registrant be elected to the sought after office, the Registrant proposes that he would act as a Senator of the Italian Republic engaging in activities of representation on behalf of his constituency, Italian citizens residing in North and Central America, in the Senate of the Italian Republic.
