This letter will serve to confirm the agreement for representation and consulting services to be provided by Jason Miko to VMRO-DPMNE.

Parties: This agreement is made May 29, 2006, between Jason Miko and VMRO-DPMNE.

Scope of Work: My work on behalf of VMRO-DPMNE will focus primarily upon the following:

- ▶ Review of your campaign platform and strategy including all materials in English for distribution to international audiences (including web page)
- ▶ General communications, including speech writing and letters, but especially those from you to the international community
- ▶ Assistance and review of messages, themes and delivery
- ▶ Suggestions for strategy including opposition research
- ▶ Assistance with international press, including reaching out to my contacts
- ▶ Issue understanding and development
- ▶ Reaching out to political and policy decision makers in Washington, DC to the extent possible
- ▶ Other tasks as necessitated by you and your campaign team

Fees: In consideration for the services provided, VMRO-DPMNE agrees to pay a flat rate of \$7,500 for the term of this contract which includes fees and expenses. \$3,500 is payable upfront and \$4,000 is payable after the July 5 elections.

Confidentiality: I recognize that in the course of my representation, I could become aware of information, practices or policies which you wish kept confidential. I agree to

maintain that confidentiality and will not disclose to any outside party the information either during the period of a contract or afterwards, to the extent permitted by law.


Term: This agreement will last through the parliamentary elections in Macedonia on July 5, 2006.
