Dear President Wade:

It is indeed an honor to consult with you and to provide representation for The Office of the President with respect to your efforts to seek a third term as President of The Republic of Senegal. I will lead a team of lawyers and professionals at McKenna Long & Aldridge (hereinafter "MLA") who have been assembled to research and analyze your authority to seek a third term under the Senegalese Constitution and other relevant laws, create a white paper that discusses our conclusions, and develop and implement an agreed upon protocol for sharing these findings with appropriate officials and interested parties in the United States and in The Republic of Senegal. We would like to present our white paper findings to you in Senegal in early November and in accordance with your schedule.

We can perform this work under the following terms:

- (1) A retainer in the amount of \$100,000 to be paid upon execution of this engagement letter;
 - (2) A \$50,000 fee for researching and drafting the white paper, and
- (3) A \$50,000 per month flat fee for developing and implementing an agreed upon protocol whereby MLA will share the results of our findings with appropriate officials and interested parties in the United States and Senegal.

I would note at the outset that we expect two trips to Senegal for myself and one other person between now and February of 2012 when the election will occur. I would appreciate your consideration of this expected expense in your budgeting process.

For example, you agree that we may represent debtors, trustees, examiners, or official committees in bankruptcy cases in which you are a creditor or a party in interest and in regard to which you may have an adverse interest to those debtors, trustees, examiners, or official committees so long as such representation is not substantially related to MLA's representation of The Office of the President, Republic of Senegal.

MLA's record retention policy provides for client's files to be kept for ten (10) years after the client's matter has been closed. At the conclusion of the retention period, the file will be destroyed unless the client requests alternate arrangements. Upon request, we will return any personal property or original documents furnished to us in the course of representation as soon as the matter is closed.
