No executed written agreement exists at present. However, the general terms agreed upon between the Registrant and the foreign principal include a monthly flat fee payment plus reimbursement of expenses. A portion of the flat fee (\$50,000/month) covers activities regulated by FARA and another portion of the flat fee covers activities outside of the United States that are not regulated by FARA.

The registrant will perform the services on a rolling basis and will report progress and discuss objectives with the foreign principal on rolling basis. When necessary, the registrant will make a written report of progress or will forward reports, articles or other such materials as may be relevant. If either the registrant or the foreign principal elects to terminate the engagement, that will be done after communication between the parties.
