Dear Mrs Riva Levinson,

Further to your memorandum of engagement of the 23th /03/2015 addressed to the office of the Personal Representative in charge of sexual violence, we are hereby providing our feedback and acceptance for an initial 3 months proposed technical assistance as per our last phone and email discussion, subject to minor amendments.

We should sign this engagement letter and move forward.

1. Fees payment amount and disbursement :

- A 3 month retainer fee of 20,000 \$USD for communication, resource mobilization and lobby services payable 50 % upon the New York visit or between the 10th and 14th April 2015
- This transfer should be made by bank swift for a total amount of 30,000 \$USD, the balance being paid 30 days to the end of the full mission on the 15th August 2015
- A provision of 20,000 \$USD (reduced from the 40,000\$USD), to be justified will be available for the travel expenses at a reasonable cost according to fare or price negotiated, for one mission to Kinshasa covering two persons including the trip from Washington DC to New York and any other due authorized travel related to the purpose of the mission.

2. Period of technical assistance :

- From 1st to 30th April 2015 (30 days)
- From 1st to 30th May 2015 (30 days)
- From 1st to 15th June 2015 (15 days), and 15th to 30th June, subject of the USA Agenda for the Office of the Representative, (15 days)
- From 1st to 15th September 2015 (15 days)
