Registrant's United Kingdom affiliate Fleishman-Hillard Group Limited (FHGL) has an agreement to provide communications, and media and public relations services to GAFI. FHGL provides services from its office in the United Kingdom. FHGL requested Registrant's media relations experts in the United States to arrange media interviews in New York City for the Minister of Investment, to occur between February 23 - March 31, 2009. The budget for Registrant's fees and costs for the media relations services: \$14,750.00 for professional fees and out-of-pocket expenses.

7. Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.

FHGL is a United Kingdom corporation owned by the ultimate parent company of Registrant. Under the agreement between FHGL and GAFI, FHGL has agreed to provide the professional services described in Section 6 above from the United Kingdom, and FHGL has requested Registrant's media relations experts to arrange the media interviews as described above to enable the Minister of Investment to promote Egypt as an attractive destination for foreign investment. Registrant's media relations experts performed the services and contacted the media outlets as described in Section 8 below.

8. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

At the request of FHGL, Registrant's media experts in New York City contacted journalists in the United States at the following media outlets to arrange media interviews for His Excellency Dr. Mahmoud Mohieldin, Minister of Investment, so that he could promote economic investment/development in Egypt: Reuters, Dow Jones, BusinessWeek, Fortune, National Public Radio, Barron's, Global Investing Expert, Focus Point Press, Emerging Manager Focus, Global Finance, and International Business. Registrant provided these services between February 23 and March 31, 2009; and, at this time, Registrant does not have any future plans or engagements by FHGL to provide any other services to the Foreign Principal. Registrant will update its FARA filings accordingly if such circumstances change.

Our response to Item 9 above is a qualified "yes" for the following reasons: Although Registrant's employees helped to arrange media contacts and interviews to enable Dr. Mohieldin to speak directly to media to promote economic investment/development in Egypt, Registrant's employees did not speak for or on behalf of the Foreign Principal. Dr. Mohieldin addressed the media audiences as the representative for the Foreign Principal. Registrant's primary role in the U.S. has been to coordinate the opportunities for the Foreign Principal to address interested media audiences.
