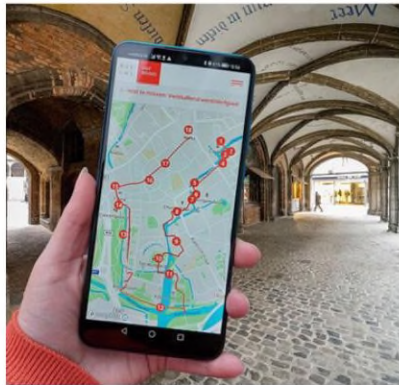

Restoration of Ghent Altarpiece continues



The Ghent Altarpiece, that had been partially restored in anticipation of the 2020 Jan Van Eyck year in Ghent, will be fully restored in the coming years.

The previous restoration work leading up to the 2020 commemorative year, included approx. 60% of the painting. The remaining un-restored panels will also be restored. The progress of the restoration works is again taking place in the [workshop at the Museum of Fine Arts \(MSK\) in Ghent](#). The public can follow the work during

the MSK's opening hours. The works are expected to be completed in spring 2026.

Situated in the north of Belgium, Flanders boasts six beautifully preserved historic cities: **Antwerp, Bruges, Brussels, Ghent, Leuven, and Mechelen.**
