Dr. Abdulkarim also serves as Chairman of the Board of Directors of a large, Iraqi security company, Iraqi Establishments Protection Company (IEPC). For several years, IEPC has provided physical protection and security services to the U.S. Military and to U.S. contractors in their efforts to maintain order and re-establish infrastructure in Iraq.



Ms. Bitar has been retained by Dr. Nahro Al-Husseini to act as a consultant and liaison promoting a relationship between Dr. Al-Husseini and the United States Department of Defense. In doing so, Ms. Bitar will educate the officials of the U.S. Government as to the compatibility between CINU's goals and those of the U.S. Government.
