Ambassador Pinzón Welcomes Colombian Consuls from Across the United States

Washington, DC — Colombian Ambassador to the United States Juan Carlos Pinzón today welcomed Consul Generals from Colombia's consulates in 12 U.S. cities. They are in town to receive an update on the Embassy's work to advance bilateral priorities in Washington and to hear from U.S. government officials about policies that affect the communities in which they serve.

The visiting consults represent Atlanta, Boston, Chicago, Houston, Los Angeles, Miami, Newark, New York, Orlando, San Francisco, San Juan and Washington, DC.

"This visit provides our team with an opportunity to coordinate with and have discussions around Colombia's key policy priorities as they relate to the United States," said Ambassador Pinzón. "We welcome them and look forward to a robust dialogue."

During the two-day meeting, the Consuls will hear from Ambassador Pinzón and other Embassy officials about the policymaking landscape, the strong bipartisan U.S.-Colombia relationship and the next phase in the partnership – Peace Colombia.

The visiting delegation will also meet with representatives from U.S. government agencies to advance cooperation across a number of areas. Today, they will meet with representatives from the Federal Emergency Management Agency, and tomorrow with Department of Homeland Security, Immigration Customs Enforcement, Customs and Border Protection and Citizenship and Immigration Services representatives.
