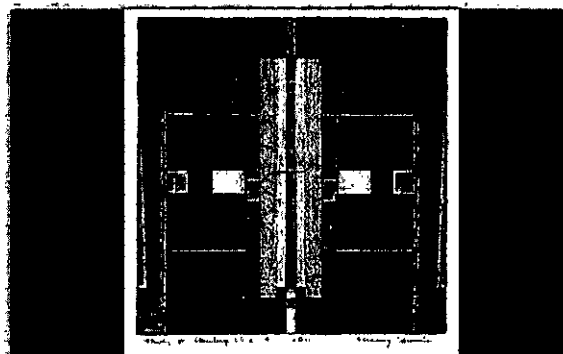
## Events Around Town

New York-based group Bulla en el Barrio will perform *bullerengue*, an Afro-Colombian musical genre on August 25 at The Kennedy Center. The group is composed of a lead singer, a chorus of four women and two drummers who bring their talents together with the goal of preserving and transmitting to new audiences the ancestral sounds of Colombia.



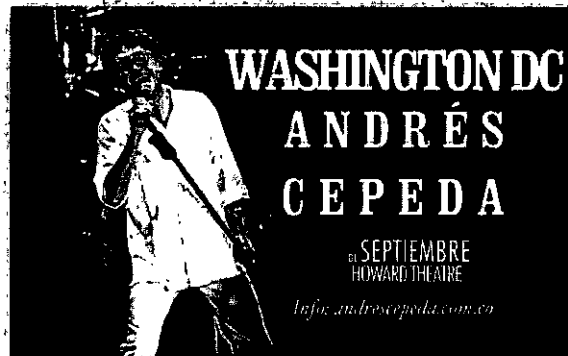
Bulla en el Barrio has participated in the Afro-Latino Festival in New York and is becoming an icon in Colombian folklore.

Andrés Cepeda is an icon of romantic ballads and is one of Colombia's and Latin America's most influential singers. In 2013, he received a Latin Grammy Award for his album "Lo mejor que hay en mi vida."



With a musical career spanning over 20 years, Cepeda is known for his romantic songs that have climbed to the top of international charts. He has also collaborated with artists such as Kanny García, Tommy Torres and Ricardo Montaner.

Carlos Sánchez is one of Cali's top comedians. He has been the only Colombian comedian invited to the "Viña del Mar" song festival in Chile, which is one of the largest music festivals in Latin America. During this year's festival, Sánchez received the Golden and Silver Seagulls, the highest honors granted by the public.
