



Amre Moussa – A veteran Egyptian diplomat and politician, Amre Moussa served as Egypt’s Minister of Foreign Affairs from 1991 to 2001 and later as Secretary-General of the Arab League (2001–2011). He played a key role in shaping Egypt’s foreign policy and Arab diplomacy during his tenure. Following the 2011 revolution, he was a prominent presidential candidate in Egypt’s first post-revolution election.
