



In consultation with the Moroccan American Center for Policy, the registrant provides media support and prepares and distributes information promoting the interests and image of Morocco, including highlighting progress in the areas of women's rights, human rights and press freedom; internationally recognized democratic elections; Morocco's autonomy initiative for the Western Sahara; and strengthened bilateral ties between Morocco and the United States. This includes preparing and distributing to media written materials including press releases, fact sheets and position papers, as well as media training Moroccan American Center for Policy spokespersons.

I am pleased to inform you that the Moroccan American Center for Policy (MACP) will retain the services of Avalanche Strategic Communications (ASC) for the calendar year 2007.

In this regard, ASC will provide services related to the objectives of the organization and its related NGOs, the Moroccan American Cultural Center (MACC) and Moroccan American Trade & Investment Council (MATIC), in terms of positively affecting relations between Morocco and the United States. ASC will focus on strategic and programming services related to the media, news and policy makers, NGOs and influential organizations, outreach to the Jewish community and media, and other groups and individuals that impact US foreign policy.

The agreement to provide services commences 1 January 2007 for a monthly fee of \$10,000 based on invoices submitted monthly. Expenses will be reimbursed according to the guidelines attached to this letter.




