

Dear Mr. Kam:

We are pleased that you have asked Nelson Mullins Riley & Scarborough LLP ("Nelson Mullins") to provide the Embassy of the Republic of Korea (the "Embassy") with advisory services and representation in the United States (the "Representation"). **Scope of Representation**

We will devote our best efforts to representing the Embassy, and, in doing so, we will strictly adhere to both the legal and moral obligations of our profession. Those obligations may include the requirement that we register as a foreign agent working on the Embassy's behalf under the Foreign Agents Registration Act. We will review our activity under this engagement and, if registration is required, a copy of this engagement letter will be filed with the U.S. Department of Justice.



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**Term of Engagement, Fees and Expenses**
