

We are pleased that you have asked Nelson Mullins Riley & Scarborough LLP ("Nelson Mullins") to provide the Embassy of the Republic of Korea (the "Embassy") with advisory services and representation in the United States (the "Representation"). This letter will confirm our engagement and describe the basis on which we will provide services to you.

Scope of Representation

The scope of the Representation under this engagement will include the professional public affairs and consulting services to further strengthen the U.S.-Korea relations and expand the Embassy's network with the Congress during the 2021 sessions of the 117th Congress.

We will devote our best efforts to representing the Embassy, and, in doing so, we will strictly adhere to both the legal and moral obligations of our profession. Those obligations may include the requirement that we register as a foreign agent working on the Embassy's behalf under the Foreign Agents Registration Act. We will review our activity under this engagement and, if registration is required, a copy of this engagement letter will be filed with the U.S. Department of Justice.

Term of Engagement, Fees and Expenses

The term of this engagement will be for six (6) months, starting on January 1, 2021. The term may be extended at the Embassy's discretion. The Embassy will pay Nelson Mullins a quarterly fee of US\$ 67,500 in advance. The payment is due upon the Embassy's receipt of our invoice. In addition, administrative costs under this engagement (e.g. telephone, fax, general document production, research, and administrative support) are included in the retainer. Extraordinary expenses outside of normal administrative costs, such as travel and translation costs will be reimbursed at cost with no additional administrative fees by the Embassy.
