This included working with local think-tanks and non-governmental organizations on issues such as Balkan integration, a visa-free EU regime for Albania, and regional leadership.

Ministry of Coordination of Production, Employment, and Competitiveness; Republic of Ecuador: Blue Star Strategies, LLC has been providing communications and investment strategy consulting for the Ministry of Coordination, of Production, Employment and Competitiveness of Ecuador. For this purpose we carried out an analysis of Ecuador's image as a foreign investment destination based on the international press and personal interviews to people in the private sector. Additionally, we researched and created a list of companies in key sectors that could potentially invest in Ecuador.


