

Footnote: Political activity as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act means any activity which the person engaging in believes will, or that the person intends to, in any way influence any agency or official of the Government of the United States or any section of the public within the United States with reference to formulating, adopting, or changing the domestic or foreign policies of the United States or with reference to the political or public interests, policies, or relations of a government of a foreign country or a foreign political party.

8. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal. If yes, describe fully.

The Registrant, a U.S. citizen of Pakistani origin, has had a personal relationship with President Pervez Musharraf since 2004. Beginning in the summer of 2010, the Registrant, voluntarily and on his own initiative, began assisting President Musharraf with the coordination of educational and charitable activities of interest to the former president. Registrant assists President Musharraf with these activities without compensation and without direction or control by, but with the general assent of, President Musharraf. The educational activity consists of operating the global office of President Musharraf virtually using Registrant's business address; coordinating paid public lectures; and serving as liaison to a speakers' bureau. Such activities qualify for the exemption from registration under section 3 of the Act. The charitable activity includes using Registrant's business address as the address for the Pervez Musharraf Foundation, an entity organized under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (<http://www.musharrafoundation.org/>), as well as serving as a board member and as the corporate secretary of the foundation. Because the Musharraf Foundation is organized in the United States, it is not subject to registration under the Act.

According to the regulations promulgated under FARA, the term "foreign principal" includes a person any of whose activities are directed or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign principal as defined by FARA. FARA Regulations § 5.100(8). While the activities engaged in by the Registrant to date either are not subject to registration or qualify for exemptions under the Act and the regulations promulgated there under, the Registrant determined to register out of the abundance of caution because President Musharraf, as an individual who is a person outside of the United States and as an individual who remains a political figure in Pakistan, meets the statutory definition of a foreign principal, and because anticipated activity by Registrant could constitute political activity under section 1(o) of the Act. Such anticipated activity includes scheduling meetings with covered government officials for and with President Musharraf. Should any such activity occur, Registrant will include a description of such activity on Supplemental Statements required under the Act.
