

Footnote: Political activity as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act means any activity which the person engaging in believes will, or that the person intends to, in any way influence any agency or official of the Government of the United States or any section of the public within the United States with reference to formulating, adopting, or changing the domestic or foreign policies of the United States or with reference to the political or public interests, policies, or relations of a government of a foreign country or a foreign political party.

The All Pakistan Muslim League LLC (Registrant) was organized in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in October 2010. The name of the LLC was selected because it, voluntarily and on its own initiative, supports the principles and the mission of the All Pakistan Muslim League, a political party organized in Pakistan (APML Pakistan), specifically to support the election of Pervez Musharraf to office in Pakistan. Although the Registrant's business activity was defined as "political fundraising" on its organizing documents (included with this Registration Statement), that activity does not equate to political fundraising as is defined under the Act. Rather, all funds raised by Registrant will be used to cover expenses for educational public events held strictly in the United States to help promote the shared goals and objectives between Registrant and APML Pakistan. Registrant does not presently plan to engage in fundraising for APML Pakistan as that term is defined by the Act. Registrant understands that should it collect or receive contributions, loans, money, or other things of value for a foreign principal as part of a fundraising campaign that it will be required to submit an Exhibit D to the Department of Justice, and all such activity would need to otherwise comply with both U.S. and Pakistani law. Registrant does not presently plan to engage in political activity for APML Pakistan as that term is defined by the Act. Registrant understands that should it engage in such activity it would be subject to reporting on a Supplemental Statement.

To date, Registrant has organized community events across the United States in which President Pervez Musharraf appeared and spoke. According to the regulations promulgated under the Act, the term "foreign principal" includes a person any of whose activities are directed or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign principal as defined by the Act. FARA Regulations § 5.100(8). Registrant has not engaged in any activity that has been directly or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by APML Pakistan. There is no formal or informal agreement between the Registrant and APML Pakistan, nor is there (nor will there be) any compensation from APML Pakistan to the Registrant.

While the activities engaged in by the Registrant to date qualify for exemptions under the Act and the regulations promulgated there under, the Registrant determined to register out of the abundance of caution because APML Pakistan, as a foreign political party, meets the statutory definition of a foreign principal, and because the phrase "for or in the interests of a foreign principal" is contained in FARA regulations (and not otherwise defined) in connection with how it views a "fund-raising campaign" (and not otherwise defined) by a foreign agent. FARA Regulations § 5.201(e). Registrant acknowledges that funds it raises to support its interests could be construed as being in the collateral but indirect interests of the APML Pakistan. In addition, Dr. Nasim Ashraf (a joint citizen of the United States and Pakistan) is the Executive Director of Registrant, served as an appointee of President Musharraf, and continues to be described in the media as a "close associate" of the former president (*See e.g.*, <http://www.topnews.in/people/nasim-ashraf> (visited on December 26, 2010), who has also been publicly described as the founder of the APML Pakistan.
