Embassy of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan

From November 19, 2010 to September 30, 2011, W2 Group, Inc. provided strategic communications advice as it relates to the foreign principal's development and implementation of a media and public relations campaign in the United States. These services were provided pursuant to an agreement with Monitor Company Group LP ("Monitor"), under which the registrant served as a subcontractor to Monitor.

Government of Rwanda

From September 1, 2009 to December 31, 2010, W2 Group, Inc. provided public relations counsel, strategies, and outreach to the foreign principal as it relates to the foreign principal's development and implementation of a media and public relations campaign in the United States.

The General People's Committee of Libya

From February 1, 2007 to March 31, 2007, W2 Group, Inc., through its subsidiary Racepoint Group, Inc., provided public relations and media services to the foreign principal in relation to events surrounding the 30th anniversary of the announcement of the People's Authority of Libya. These services were provided pursuant to an agreement with Monitor Company Group LP ("Monitor"), under which the registrant served as a subcontractor to Monitor. Additionally, in July 2007 and from September 2007 to December 2007, the registrant, through its subsidiary Racepoint Group, undertook two short-term assignments for the registrant: (i) one to arrange interviews of a Libyan official regarding HIV-positive children in Libya; and (ii) a second to publicize a Libyan official's visit to France and Portugal.

Embassy of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan

The registrant assisted the foreign principal in developing social and traditional media plans with respect to issues affecting U.S.—Jordan relations. Additionally, in March 2011, the registrant arranged for media briefings with Newsweek and Reuters in connection with King Abdullah II's book release, and conducted subsequent followup with those publications.

Government of Rwanda

The registrant's public relations activities included political activities intended to communicate successes by the foreign principal to U.S. audiences, including:

- Contributing images to Flickr;
- Outreach to United Kingdom NGOs, think tanks, and academics;
- Outreach to United Kingdom, African, and German press on a variety of issues, including interviews with Rwandan government officials and op-eds and letters to the editor on key issues;
- Distributing press releases regarding key issues (appearances of the Rwandan President; the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda (ICTR); local news; UN reports) to Business Wire;
- Distributing op-eds and letters to the editor to U.S. media (including the Huffington Post, the New York Times, the Wall Street Journal, the Washington Post, the Boston Globe, and the websites Ecolocalizer.com, Ms. Magazine, and This Africa Online) on a variety of issues, including Rwandan elections and the Rwandan political system; genocide denial laws; Rwanda's progress; women leadership; biodiversity; freedom of speech; and a youth center in Rwanda;
- Distributing press releases regarding the arrest of Peter Erlinder in May and June 2010 to U.S. and international media (including Business Wire, the Associated Press, Bloomberg

BusinessWeek, the Chicago Tribune, CNN, the Los Angeles Times, Newsweek, Reuters, the Boston Globe, Christian Science Monitor, the New York Times, the Wall Street Journal, the Washington Post, Time, U.S. News & World Report, USA Today, and USA Today Magazine), submitting a letter to the editor of the Boston Globe, and distributing two op-eds to the Huffington Post;

- Contacting media (United Kingdom and other international publications, as well as Marie Claire, Newsweek, Women's Day, and O Magazine) in June, July, and August 2010 regarding possible coverage of gender equality issues; and
- Arranging for interviews of Rwandan government officials with U.S. and foreign media (including the New York Times, Newsweek, Forbes, Bloomberg, Reuters, AP, the Wall Street Journal, Dow Jones, NPR, the Boston Globe, and the Montreal Gazette) and think tanks (Brookings Institute and the Woodrow Wilson Center for International Scholars) in June/July and September 2010.

The General People's Committee of Libya

From February 1, 2007 to March 31, 2007, the registrant provided public relations and media services, which included political activities intended to promote events surrounding the 30th anniversary of the announcement of the People's Authority of Libya (including a March 2, 2007 debate in Libya arranged by the foreign principal and Monitor). These activities included outreach to print media in Europe and the foreign bureaus of U.S. media outlets (including the Washington Post) to cover the March 2 debate and follow-up contacts with these media outlets; outreach to the foreign bureaus of the BBC, Al-Jazeera, AP Television, Reuters Television, and CNN regarding coverage of the debate; and distribution of a press release via Business Wire's Global circuit. Additionally, the registrant undertook two subsequent short-term assignments for the foreign principal (neither of which was the subject of a written agreement): a one-month assignment in July 2007 to arrange interviews of a Libyan official with the foreign bureaus of Newsweek, BBC, Time and two wire services, and an assignment from September 2007 to December 2007 to publicize a Libyan official's visit to France and Portugal through outreach to foreign media outlets and a press release sent via Business Wire's Global circuit.
