5. Assisted in drafting a Memorandum of Understanding between the University of Khartoum and Johns Hopkins University on educational exchange and joint research on archaeology.
6. Continued to advise on the legal aspects of a planned traveling exhibition of artifacts from the Sudan National Museum.
7. Provided legal advice on the application of the Sudanese Sanctions Regulations to a study group that the Woodrow Wilson Center for International Scholars is planning on U.S. policy towards Sudan
8. Provided legal advice on the application of the Sudanese Sanctions Regulations to a contract between General Electric and the Republic of Sudan regarding construction of the Merowe Dam power station project on the Nile.
9. Assisted in discussions with the University of Indiana regarding educational exchange and joint research programs with the University of Khartoum.
10. Provided legal advice on Sudan's National Dialogue.

1. I had a telephone conversation on August 3, 2015, with Ambassador Susan Page, Senior Advisor to the U.S. Special Envoy for Sudan and South Sudan, U.S. State Department of State. The purpose of the conversation was to ascertain the position of the Department on the issue of debt relief.
2. On June 4, 2015, I met with Janelle Guest, Congressional Fellow, office of Rep. Charles Rangel (D-NY), to discuss the issue of debt relief.
3. On October 13, 2015, I submitted informational materials on the need for debt relief for Sudan to Travis Adkins, Staff Director, and Margot Sullivan, Senior Policy Advisor. Both Mr. Adkins and Ms. Sullivan are on the staff of Rep. Karen Bass (D-CA).
4. On October 14, 2015, I had a telephone conference with Mr. Adkins to discuss the issue of debt relief for Sudan.
5. On August 26, 2015, I drafted for John Edward Hurley, Chairman of the McLendon Group, a suggested invitation to a program put on by the McLendon Group. The program took place on September 3, 2015; it concerned Sudan debt relief; and its featured speaker was Ibrahim Ahmed Omer, Speaker, Sudanese National Assembly, Republic of Sudan.
6. I submitted an informational document on the need for debt relief for Sudan to the following persons:

 9. I met on September 29, 2015, with Michael Van Dusen, Consultant, Woodrow Wilson Center for International Scholars, and Alan Goulty, co-chair of an informal Wilson Center working group on Sudan, to ascertain the level of interest in a program on debt relief for Sudan by the Center.
